Project Description

Nelson & Pope provided the Suffolk County Dept. of Public Works with construction observation and support services for the rehabilitation of CR 17, Carleton Avenue, from CR 100, Suffolk Avenue to Bretton Road in Central Islip. The project was built with federal aid funds and all of the inspection paperwork conformed to NYSDOT and FHWA standards for County reimbursement. N&P provided a Resident Engineer and inspection support staff for this 1.2 mile project.

The project included pavement widening; traffic signal modifications; drainage modifications; asphalt shoulder reconstruction; asphalt concrete resurfacing; new curb and sidewalk; pavement markings and signage.
