



Project Description

Nelson & Pope provided engineering, environmental, and surveying services for the development of 210 units of senior housing in two buildings on 12 acres on Hempstead Harbor, along with 1,800 l.f. of bulkhead and shoreline revetment. The property is located under the viaduct on NYS Rte. 25A. The design team worked with the developer, the Inc. Village of Roslyn and the NYSDEC to prepare a plan that would enhance and, at the same time, stabilize the shoreline of the old fuel terminal. The improvements feature a public access pedestrian walkway along the shoreline.
